Sandburg PTA Meeting Minutes March 14, 2022 – 7 pm on Zoom



Meeting called to order by President Patti Berner at 7:02 pm. Pledge of Allegiance.

Special Guests: Kerry Leischel (Director Of Curriculum And Instruction) and Sarah Cannon (Asst Director Student Services) - Social Emotional Learning (SEL)

D205 was trying to figure out how to make SEL data-driven so we can assess it (like we do for academics). D205 decided to go with a mix of <u>Panorama Ed</u> and <u>Casel's Framework</u>:



Students took a survey through Panorama Ed, and data was collected across the district to identify trends. The survey was given in fall 2021 and will be given again in spring 2022 to see if the students are progressing. The Fall 2021 baseline survey scores will be considered the D205 starting benchmark.

General Results Across the district: strong in self-awareness (emotions), need to work on selfmanagement (emotions, frustration, calming self) and grit (a portion of self-management that includes setting & completing goals and confidence that you'll be able to apply this year's learning to next year). Sandburg's results: need to work more on emotion regulation, grit & growth mindset

How Sandburg is addressing these (info from Mrs. F):

Have been working on these topics in FLL - especially 8th grade. Half the grade is working 3x/ week with counselor and other half 3x/week in counseling circles. 6th & 7th grades do 1x/week in counseling circles.

Mrs. F checks in with staff weekly to find out what SEL stuff they have done that week in the classroom.

There is an SEL committee as well. Tier 1 (includes all kids) - there are representatives from each school on the committee. They are looking at what D205 has for universal supports and what should be added. Also determining how to fill in the gaps we've seen on the panorama surveys, as well as other necessary things we know are missing. After the committee works on Tier 1 (all kids), they will then develop Tier 2 & then Tier 3 supports (for kids who need extra).

Sandburg is doing pretty well! General response from parents and students across the district has been positive so far. Panorama uses Castle which is the gold standard in SEL. Parents do have the option to opt their kids out of the surveys if they would like.
