York Students Report—Outdoor Classroom

York Invite to Teach students presented their plan to create a learning space for Sandburg. The program introduces students to teaching/education as a career option. Plan to build the benches with 7th grade acceleration class with teacher supervision. Cost will be roughly \$400 and the group is requesting funds from the PTA and/or Sandburg families.
